4. Principal's Report:
 - Imagine School at Broward will receive an additional 5 year accreditation at the June 30 ADvancEd Meeting. We are proud of our report and will continue to work on the areas needing improvement.
 - All staff received their A+ Money on March 20
 - All students successfully took the FSA ELA Writes. We had no glitches with either the computers or the paper-based model.
 - We are working hard on our upcoming assessments.
 - Technology Task Force has been formed to look at our infrastructure, professional development, and basic classroom technology needs.
 - Passed Coral Springs Fire Inspection.
 - Successful Code Red Drill (this is a lock down drill in case of an intruder or other serious need)
 - Field Day was a great event. All students participated, lots of fun, and camaraderie.
 - Highly successful Spring Book Fair. Grossed over \$12,000. We now have over \$14,000 in scholastic dollars to spend for the school.
 - Lottery closed. We had several open houses during the day and the evening. We received over 562 applications. We pulled the lottery and are in the process of sending out notices.
 - Have been working on a plan for next year and the coming years. We will be over in 6th grade and will need to adjust classrooms. If we keep taking in 108 students in each grade, we will be over the amount of classrooms by 5. We are looking at co-teaching in Grades 2 & 3.
 - Completed all of Imagine Surveys: family, student (grades 3-8), and staff. Attached results of Family Survey. We went up in 18 areas, remained the same in 5, and went down in 5 areas.
 - Collected over \$1,800.00 for a young family at our school who is having serious medical conditions.
 - Jason May, 7th grader, was a finalist for the State Geography Bee.
 - **Imagine's State Science Fair.** We are very proud of our students we did very well in winning many top entries. Our students competed against over 200 students. Congratulations to these students:
