We are writing with important information regarding how Imagine Schools is approaching our planning for the next school year, which is scheduled to start on August 19th. Please be assured we are working on safe and healthy solutions, and no matter what circumstances we find ourselves in August, Imagine Schools will be ready to educate all of our students Pre-K-12.

Looking ahead, Imagine Schools, in cooperation with our districts, State Department of Education, and local health agencies, is preparing for the 2020-2021 school year with multiple COVID-19 scenarios in mind, taking into consideration the varying needs of our students, families, staff, and facilities. We are, of course, exploring all methods and formats of instruction in order to ensure that whatever the circumstances, we are prepared to educate and support your children. Decisions regarding when and how to reopen school—and whether to extend distance learning—will be guided by public health officials and other government authorities. The health, safety, and social and emotional well-being of students remain our top priority.

We have formed a region-wide task force that is researching and evaluating all potential options for returning to school in August.
