The food packaging shall not be compromised nor the true appearance, color, or quality of a food be intentionally altered.</p>
<p>Violation #36. Thermometers provided & accurate Refrigerator thermometer not located for easy viewing. Locate thermometer for easy viewing.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Thermometers must be calibrated to ensure accuracy in accordance with Rule requirements. Food thermometers scaled in Celsius (C) shall be accurate to plus or minus 1°C or in Fahrenheit (F), accurate to plus or minus 2°F. Food thermometers should be accessible for use by employees and have a probe size appropriate to the food item.</p>
<p>Violation #39. No Contamination (preparation, storage, display) Plastic cup held inside condiment container. Use scoops to prevent cross contamination.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). Food shall be protected from sources of contamination and stored in a clean, dry location at least 6 inches above the floor.</p>
<p>Violation #53. Toilet facilities: supplied, & cleaned Toilet door kept open, missing self-closing door. Install self-closing door.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Toilet facilities shall meet applicable plumbing code, be kept clean, provided with toilet paper and covered waste receptacle, and utilize self-closing doors.</p>
